- TRE/2021/0987 We (the National Trust) wish to replace the existing 620m stock fence as it is beyond reasonable repair and is no longer stock proof in several places. The fence will be replaced to the same specification as the existing, which comprises stock netting with two runs of barbed wire over. The trees as detailed below and shown on the map (Doc 1) will require some pruning or coppicing along the existing fence line to enable the new fence to be installed. Location. Type. Work required. T1 White Poplar. Fallen live tree to be cut back off fence. T2 Sycamore. Crown lift off fence. T3 Hawthorn. Crown lift off fence. T4 Hawthorns (x4). x3 trees to side up & x1 to coppice. T5 Birch. Remove two 100mm limbs. T6 Oak. Remove 200mm limb. T7 Hawthorn. Remove 300mm limb. T8 Alder. Crown lift. 600 - 601 Conservation Parkland Kedleston Hall Kedleston
